The album changed from MY AUTOBIOGRAPHY into a ROCK OPERA about King Solomon completing his legendary Temple in Jerusalem.

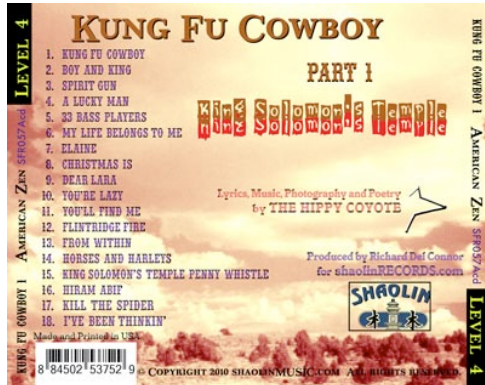
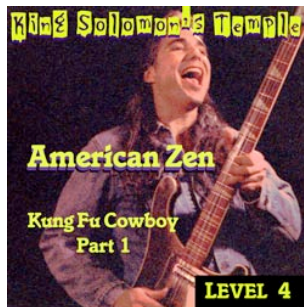
By organizing the storyline more distinctly, I was able to finish mixing the album telling the stories of these characters, rather than just my story and the characters from my reality.

Sheesh. I write rock operas, even when I'm trying not to write rock operas.

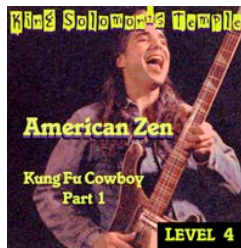
My life is a rock opera.

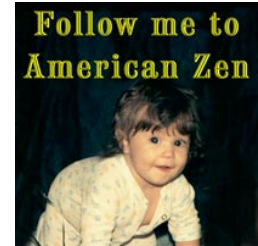
